

Magic Ring Tutorial

*Note: this tutorial uses a double wrap, creating a two-strand yarn ring to crochet around. This creates a more stable ring which you may find easier to work with, however a single strand can be used if preferred.



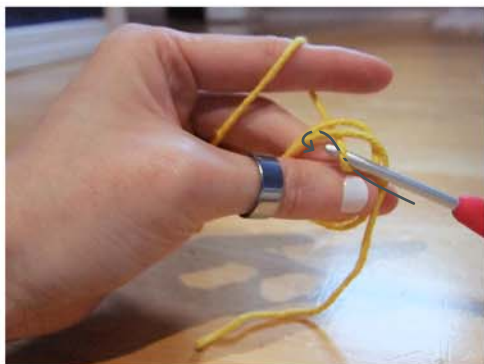
Wrap yarn around fingers as pictured*



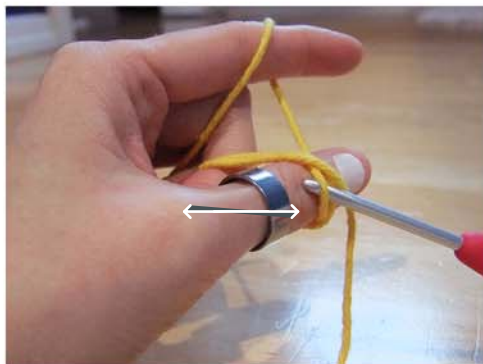
Pinch yarn loops together at base.



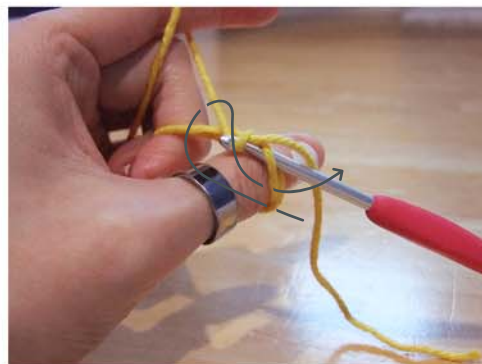
Transfer loops so that you are holding them in one hand.



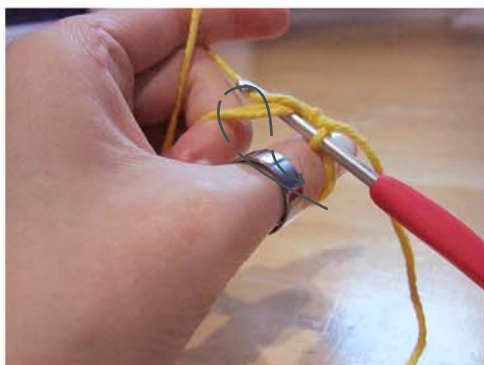
Insert hook through center of ring and use working yarn to pull up a loop.



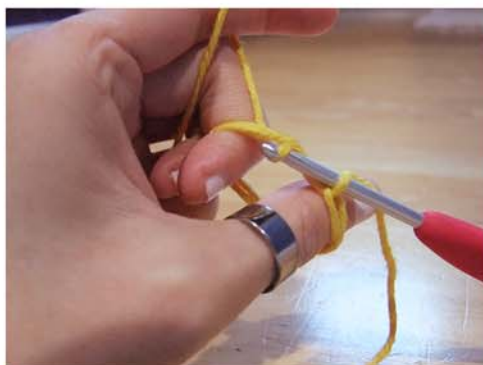
Insert your thumb and middle finger into the ring and apply opposing pressure to pull ring taut.



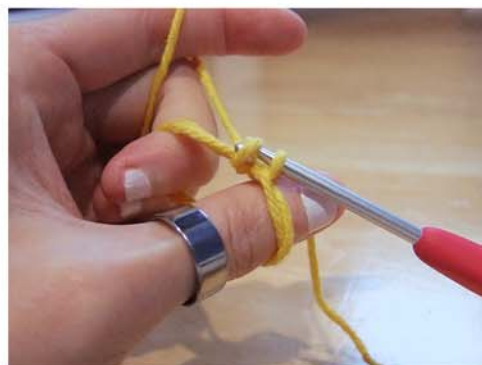
Yarn-over and pull up a single loop. You are now ready to begin crocheting.



Begin first SC: Insert hook through center of ring and wrap around working yarn.



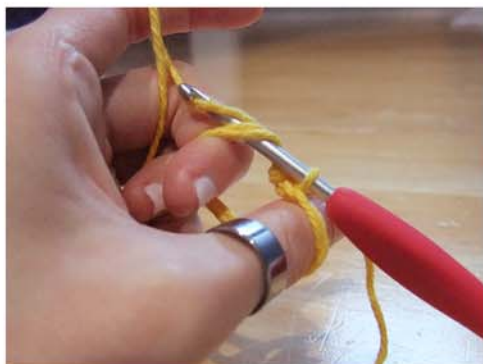
Pull a loop back through center of ring



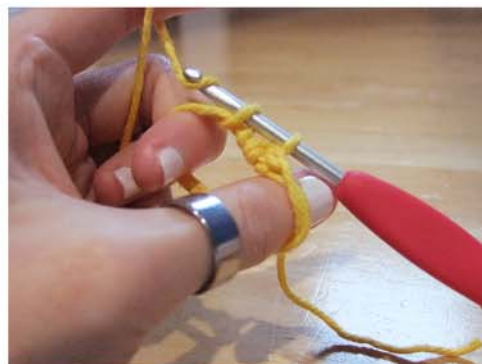
Yarn over and pull through both loops on the hook



This completes the first SC



Continue with next SC (insert hook through center of the ring, and wrap around working yarn).



Yarn over and pull through both loops on the hook. Continue until you have specified number of SC for ring.

To close ring, pull on the tail. For a double-strand ring like the one in this tutorial, pull on the tail until one of the strands of the ring begins to move. Grasp this strand and pull tight (the second strand will disappear). Pull on the tail again to tighten remaining strand.
